Transparency notification by BlackRock, Inc.

In accordance with article 14, § 1 of the law of 2 May 2007 on disclosure of major holdings, BlackRock Inc. has recently notified Umicore that it has crossed the legal threshold of 5% for the direct voting rights upwards on July 12th 2023.

The total holding of direct voting rights and equivalent financial instruments stand now at 5.52%.
