# Transparency notifications by SFPIM

In accordance with article 14, § 1 of the law of 2 May 2007 on disclosure of major holdings, *Société fédérale de Participations et d'Investissement* (SFPIM) has recently notified Umicore that it has successively crossed the statutory threshold of 3% and the regulatory threshold of 5% for the direct voting rights upwards on May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2024 and on May 8<sup>th</sup> 2024.

The total holding of direct voting rights and equivalent financial instruments stands now 5.00%.
