

Road works in the Adolf Greinerstraat

On Monday 13 January 2020, road works will start in the Adolf Greinerstraat, which will cause a great deal of inconvenience. At the request of ELIA, the contractor will then start pulling a power cable from the Titanstraat to substation 11 in the Adolf Greinerstraat. The anticipated end date of the works is 10 April 2020.

In the first two weeks, a section of the Adolf Greinerstraat and the Titanstraat will be occupied in order to perform directional drilling under the Van Praetstraat. Once these works are finished, the trenching work will start.

What is the impact on mobility?

Cyclists and pedestrians:

The cycle track remains open in both directions during the activities.

Cars and lorries:

During the directional drilling, there will be **increased inconvenience** for both cars and lorries. Traffic in the direction of Hemiksem will have right of way.

During the excavation work for the trench, from 24 January to 10 April, the Greinerstraat **will be one-way for traffic coming from Hemiksem**. Traffic in the direction of Hemiksem will be diverted via the St. Bernardsesteenweg.
