

## Transparency notification by Silchester International Investors LLP

In accordance with article 14, § 1 of the law of 2 May 2007 on the disclosure of major holdings, Umicore was recently notified by Silchester International Investors LLP that it has crossed the legal threshold of 5% for the direct voting rights upwards on February 20<sup>th</sup> 2025.

The total holding of direct voting rights and equivalent financial instruments of Silchester International Investors LLP now stands at 5.07%.
