

Transparency notification by Bank of America Corporation

In accordance with article 14, § 1 of the law of 2 May 2007 on the disclosure of major holdings, Umicore was recently notified by Bank of America Corporation that it has crossed the legal threshold of 3% for the equivalent financial instruments upwards on 10 March 2026.

The total holding of direct voting rights and equivalent financial instruments of Bank of America Corporation stands at 3.60% on 13 March 2026.
